Branding:

Linda McCarthy narrowed down the group of proposers to one firm, and is negotiating with them now. We should have a contract for your review and approval at the next meeting. The price will be within budget.

Sign Ordinance:

Ronald Jones and I have reviewed the new ordinance and met with Bob Barber to work out some revisions. We are preparing a presentation for you on the difference and will have that ready for your review and consideration at the next meeting.

Humvees:

The Humvees will soon be painted black and will have a colorful decal similar to a Diamondhead Police Officer’s badge. Special thanks to Jeannie for the computer assisted artwork.

Parking in the median:

The Police will soon begin enforcing the parking ordinance restricting parking in the median. Expect warnings at first and later tickets.

Roadway Fund Raising:

Soliciting donations or contributions in or along public roadways is not permitted under Diamondhead Traffic Regulations. This will be announced to the Police Officers and prohibited in the future.

Timeline for ADA improvements:

Anticipate advertising for contractors beginning the second week of April with a bid opening in late May.
