


1. **Call to Order**—Mayor Ingraham called the meeting to order at 1:06 p.m.
2. **Invocation**—Mayor Ingraham
3. **Pledge of Allegiance**—Councilmember Holcomb
4. **Roll Call**—The following members of Council were present: Mayor Ingraham, Dianne Ackerman, Hank Holcomb, Ernie Knobloch, Ron Rech. Councilmember Dalton Roberson attended via telephone as allowed by State statute and resolution of City Council. It was noted that Special Counsel Jerry Mills was in attendance, assisting City Attorney Bragg Williams.
5. **Confirmation or Adjustment of the Agenda Order**—Councilmember Roberson moved, seconded by Councilmember Rech, to accept the order of the Agenda.
6. **Communications/Announcements from the Mayor and Council**—The Mayor reported on his meeting with the Governor and Senator Cochran regarding issues with FEMA and MEMA arising from Hurricane Isaac and our status with the city streets.
