

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF DIAMONDHEAD, MISSISSIPPI  
DEMARCATING BAYOU DRIVE AS DIVIDING POINT FOR  
DIAMONDHEAD DRIVE NORTH AND DIAMONDHEAD DRIVE WEST**

**WHEREAS**, the dividing point for Diamondhead Drive West and Diamondhead Drive North is currently in a curved section of a residential block and as such, according to residents, has caused confusion in the area hindering deliveries and emergency response services; and


**WHEREAS**, it has been determined that Bayou Drive would better serve as the delineating line for Diamondhead Drive West and Diamondhead Drive North; and

**WHEREAS**, along with the Fire Chief for the City of Diamondhead, the five (5) homeowners with numeric addresses 84579, 84577, 84573, 84570, and 84572 and located in the subject area have all concurred with the proposed change; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED**, by the Mayor and City Council for the City of Diamondhead to demarcate Bayou Drive as the delineating line for Diamondhead Drive West and Diamondhead Drive North for all purposes, including but not limited to, mapping, United States Postal Service and E-911 services.
