

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FEES IN ASSOCIATION WITH
 THE ADOPTED FAMILY OF INTERNATIONAL CODES
 FOR THE CITY OF DIAMONDHEAD**

WHEREAS, the statues of the State of Mississippi, Section 19-5-9 of the Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended, empowered the County to enact construction codes published by a nationally recognized code group which sets minimum standards and has the proper provisions to maintain up-to-date amendments with minimum standard guides for building, plumbing, electrical, gas, sanitary, and other related codes in Mississippi; and

WHEREAS, an ordinance of the City of Diamondhead council adopted The Family of International Building Codes, regulating and governing the conditions and maintenance of all property, buildings and structures; by providing the standards for supplied utilities and facilities and other physical things and conditions essential to ensure that structures are safe, sanitary and fit for occupation and use; and the condemnation of buildings and structures unfit for human occupancy and use and the demolition of such structures in the City of Diamondhead; providing for the issuance of permits and collection of fees.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Diamondhead, Mississippi, that the following fees are amended in association with the adopted family of International Codes on October 20, 2012.

FURTHER MORE, action passed on May 6, 2014 whereby the Mayor and Council voted to suspend the Residential Building Permit Fee Schedule for single family residential building permits, new construction only, for a 2-year period beginning May 7, 2014 and ending May 6, 2016. Furthermore, to set the permit fee for the specified two-year period for single family residential new construction building permits at a flat rate of \$1,200 with re-inspections fees in the amount \$75.00 per occurrence for failure to comply with appropriate codes is hereby rescinded in its entirety.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance shall immediately take effect to protect the health, safety and welfare of its citizens and to promote economic development, notwithstanding, normal publication of notice in the local newspaper.

Plan-Checking Fees

When the valuation of the proposed construction exceeds \$500.00 and a plan is required to be submitted by IBC Section 107 and IRC Section R106, a plan –checking fee shall be paid to the building official at the time of submitting plans and specifications for checking. Said plan-checking fee shall be equal to one-half of the building permit fee as set forth in Sections IBC Section 109.2 and IRC Section R108.2. Such plan-checking fee will be a credit to the building permit fee.

Moving Fee *

For the moving of any building or structure, the fee shall be \$100.00.

Demolition Fee *

For the demolition of any building or structure, the fee shall be:

0 up to 100,000 cu ft	\$100.00
100,000 cu ft and over	\$0.50 / 1,000 cu ft

Change of Occupancy

For the change of occupancy of any building or structure, the fee shall be \$100.00.

Change of Contractor

For the change of contractor for any building or structure, the fee shall be \$100.00.

Permit Extension (good for 6 mos.)

For permit extension (good for 6 mos.) for any building or structure, the fee shall be \$50.00.

Re-inspections Fees

(a) First.....	\$25.00
(b) Second.....	\$50.00
(c) Third.....	\$75.00
(d) Each subsequent re-inspection after the third	\$100.00

Floodplain Development (in addition to any other permits).....\$50.00

Commercial Construction Trailer (per trailer).....\$100.00

Fire Alarm.....\$100.00

-----for Commercial properties, an amount equal to the permit fees based on valuation

Penalties

When work for which a permit is required by these codes (building, residential building, electrical, plumbing, fuel gas, mechanical, swimming pool and fire) is started or proceeded prior to obtaining said permit, the fees herein specified shall be doubled, but the payment of such doubled fee shall not relieve any persons from fully complying with the requirements of these codes (building, residential building, electrical, plumbing, fuel gas, mechanical, swimming pool and fire) in the execution of the work nor from any other penalties prescribed herein.

SCHEDULE OF PERMIT FEES MECHANICAL

MB101 Permit Fees

MB101.1 Initial Fee

For issuing each permit

residential rate: \$30.00 = \$3.00 per \$1,000.00 or fraction thereof

commercial rate: 1% of price of job, but no less than a minimum fee of \$50.00

MB101.2 Additional Fees

MB101.2.1 Fee for inspecting heating, ventilating, ductwork, air conditioning and refrigeration systems shall be \$30.00 for the first \$1,000.00, or fraction thereof, of valuation of the installation plus \$3.00 for each additional \$1,000.00 or fraction thereof.

MB101.2.2 Fee for inspecting repairs, alterations and additions to an existing system shall be \$5.00 plus \$3.00 for each \$1,000.00 or fraction thereof.

MB101.2.3 Fee for inspecting boilers (based upon Btu input):

33,000 Btu (1 BHp) to 165,000 (5 BHp).....	\$ 5.00
165,001 Btu (5 BHp) to 330,000 (10 BHp).....	\$10.00
330,001 Btu (10 BHp) to 1,165,000 (52 BHp).....	\$15.00
1,165,001 Btu (52 BHp) to 3,300,000 (98 BHp).....	\$25.00
over 3,300,000 Btu (98 BHp).....	\$35.00

NOTE: 1 KJ = 1.055 BTU, 1 BHp = 33,475 Btuh.

MB102 Fee For Reinspection

In case it becomes necessary to make a re-inspection of a heating, ventilation, air conditioning or refrigeration system, or boiler installation, the installer of such equipment shall pay a re-inspection fee of \$25.00.

MB103 Temporary Operation Inspection Fee

When preliminary inspection is requested for purposes of permitting temporary operation of a heating, ventilating, refrigeration, or air conditioning system, or portion thereof, a fee of \$25.00 shall be paid by the contractor requesting such preliminary inspection. If the system is not approved for temporary operation on the first preliminary inspection, the usual re-inspection fee shall be charged for each subsequent preliminary inspection for such purpose.

MB104 Self-Contained Units Less Than Two Tons

In all buildings, except one and two family dwellings, where self-contained air conditioning units of less than two tons are to be installed, the fee charged shall be \$30.00 plus the additional costs of MB 101.2.1.

APPENDIX D
SCHEDULE OF PERMIT FEES GAS PIPING

GB101 For issuing each permit, a fee of \$50.00 will be charged for residential properties, with commercial properties charged 1% of contract price, with a minimum charge of \$100.00

GB102 The total fees for inspection of consumers' gas piping at one location (including both rough and final piping inspection) shall be \$25.00 for one to four outlets, inclusive, and \$5.00 for each additional outlet;

GB103 The fees for inspecting conversion burners, floor furnaces, incinerators, boilers, or central heating or air conditioning units shall be \$25.00 for one unit and \$5.00 for each additional unit;

GB104 The fee for inspecting vented wall furnaces and water heaters shall be \$25.00 for one unit and \$5.00 for each additional unit;

GB105 If a re-inspection is required, an additional fee of \$25.00 will be charged;

GB106 If any person commences any work before obtaining the necessary permit and inspection, fees shall be doubled; and

GB107 Any and all fees shall be paid by the person to whom the permit is issued.
