II. Presentation Agenda

1. Council Comments

a. The next regularly scheduled Council Meeting will be held at 6:00 p.m. CST on March 15, 2016 in Council Chambers located at 5000 Diamondhead Circle.

- b. Mayor Schafer administered the Oaths of Office for Planning & Zoning Commissioners Nita Hensley and Don Crosby.
- c. Joseph Lopez, Councilmember Ward 1, introduced a letter explaining the recent sale of his home. He explained he was temporarily relocated to rental property outside his ward and that he is actively seeking to locate and purchase a home in Ward 1.
- d. Andrew Hinkebein, Southern District Field Representative for Senator Roger Wicker was introduced. He explained that Senator Wicker would work to support future funding needs of the City and encouraged application for MDOT's upcoming TIGER Grant that will fund capital investments in surface transportation infrastructure.

2. City Manager's Report

Solid Waste:

Bid specifications have been developed that require the same service for Diamondhead as Council instructed (a cart and one time per week pick up). Bids are set to be opened on April 5th and awarded on April 11th. The contract specifications have changed to include an initial length of 3 years with 3 one year automatic renewals and that should drive competitive pricing.

Gulf Regional Planning Commission:

I was honored to be selected as Vice-Chairman of the GRPC in officer elections last week. I have spent a few hours at their office to dig in deeper into the programs and how to tap into the funding opportunities. The GRPC has control over the use of funds for various infrastructure and planning activities. Currently, there is an open application period for the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), the deadline for applications is May 13th. I am working with the leadership to develop an application with focus on improvements to the commercial area or the multi-modal path to connect the Southside of Diamondhead underneath the Jourdan River Bridge. The completed Traffic Study will be important for gaining approval from MDOT for the project.

BP Funds:

We need to identify other projects that you might want included on the MS Restore Portal. From what I've learned that is the starting point coupled with the active participation of the members of our Go Coast 2020 team. I'll be talking to you more about that and developing a project or projects for submission.

Drainage:

The 5 contracted drainage projects are about 80% complete. We are continuing to work on a presentation to show the work accomplished and drainage needs.

Grants:

The new "Commercial Drive" funded with Small Municipalities and Limited County Population (SMLPC) Funds is moving along at a rapid pace and should be bidding the end of March or first part of April. As you are aware by the two resolutions that we had to add tonight, we are applying for a ½ mile Walking and Exercise Fitness Track that will go in the green space in front and alongside of City Hall. The application deadline is March 10th. This is a \$100,000 grant with an 80%/20% match. The Tidelands Kayak and Hiking Trail Project is under preliminary design and we anticipate bidding the project mid-May.

Infrastructure improvements update:

Awaiting signed easements for Live Oak Dr. Phase II and the new Commercial Drive to go forward with final engineering plans and advertisement for construction.
