SECTION THREE: Clovis Reed, City Manager of the City of Diamondhead, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary and pertinent to the application; and

SECTION FOUR: Clovis Reed, City Manager of the City of Diamondhead, is hereby authorized to execute a grant offer and any other documents necessary to the acceptance and implementation of the program should the project be approved.
