

**Resolution to Revise Resolution 2013-040 Establishing a
“Keep Diamondhead Beautiful” Committee and Appointing a
Representative to the Hancock Chamber Beautification Committee**

Whereas, the City of Diamondhead was incorporated on January 30, 2012, as a municipality along the Mississippi Gulf Coast in Hancock County; and


Whereas, the city of Diamondhead, like the other municipalities along the Mississippi Gulf Coast, has a desire to keep its city clean and beautiful, and

Whereas, there is an opportunity to receive support, enhance communication, and benefit from coordination of beautification efforts from the Hancock Chamber Beautification Committee and “Keep America Beautiful”, Inc.

Whereas, an organized beautification effort provides an opportunity to increase the desirability of potential business and homeowners to locate in Diamondhead and for residents to have pride in their city,

Therefore, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Diamondhead, do hereby revise Resolution 2013-040 establishing a “Keep Diamondhead Beautiful Committee” and appointing the Chairman of this committee. Resolution 2013-040 is additionally revised to provide for a minimum of four and a maximum of nine members, to be appointed to this committee with staggered terms of three years, effective January 2013. This committee will report to the City Manager for purposes of budgeting, assignments, and coordination of volunteers. Reporting on progress to the Mayor and Council will be at the first Council meeting of the month beginning February, 2013. No binding contract, nor pledge or expenditure of monies will be authorized without approval of the Mayor and City Council and appropriate action by the City Manager and/or City Clerk.
