1. The City is responsible for the safety of life, health and property of the citizens of Diamondhead, MS;

3. JEM, LLC, a local business has donated \$500.00 to the program and the City wishes to match said contribution pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. Sec. 21-19-65; and,

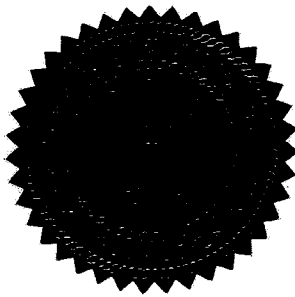
WHEREAS, during the Fourth of July holiday, many state employees will spend time with their families in Mississippi and in other states:
