

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SUBMITTAL TO NATIONAL RESOURCES CONSERVATION SERVICE (NRCS) FOR EMERGENCY WATERSHED PROTECTION PROGRAM FUNDING FOR RESTORE DRAINAGE SYSTEM ON DIAMONDHEAD DRIVE EAST AT ALKII WAY.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council for the City of Diamondhead, Mississippi are seeking funding in the amount of \$93,400 from the National Resources Conservation Service through the Emergency Watershed Protection Program to complete a drainage restoration project on Diamondhead Drive East at Alkii Way, and

WHEREAS, provided the City is awarded by the National Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) Emergency Watershed Protection funding in the amount of \$93,400, the NRCS federal share would be seventy-five percent (75%) or \$70,050 and the City of Diamondhead agrees to provide matching funds of twenty-five percent (25%) or a total of \$23,350, in the form of cash, in-kind services or a combination of both.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT IS RESOLVED that the Mayor and City Council of the City of Diamondhead, Mississippi:

SECTION 1. The City of Diamondhead shall provide the matching funds of at least twenty-five percent (25%) if awarded Emergency Watershed Protection for the drainage restoration project on Diamondhead Drive East at Alkii Way; and

SECTION 2. The Mayor and City Council authorize the City Manager to sign any and all documents pertinent to this grant application and the City is obligated to match at least twenty-five percent (25%) funds whether it- be cash, in-kind service(s) or a combination of both to meet the requirements for this grant application. The City will assume responsibility for expenditures in excess of \$93,400 for this project.

RESOLVED, this the 22 day of July, 2019.
