City Projects Update

MDOT Projects- Final striping of the roadway is hoppening. Signage will be installed in the next few weeks. The multimodel path is currently not qualifolde for use, as MDOT is working on finalizing it.

Coon Brach- The project is 180 days with a current end date of 12/13. Work now is installing the drainage culverts and inlets

Canal Dredging- Bids were rejected and project will be readvertised.

Jordan River Boardwalk- MDEQ is reviewing the updated plans and specifications.

Montjoy Creek-USACE is reviewing plans

Hazard Mitigation Program-Updated scope change to MEMA for the generator grant. An appraiser is working on the property acquisition project for residents.

Bank Stabilization- Engineers have presented preliminary design drawings for Phase 1

Pelican Cove- Drainage Project-Engineer presented the design at the last city council meeting

Rotten Bayou Nature Trail-

Engineer is currently surveying the trail to create the legal description

Fitness Park- All parties have signed lease agreement. Public Works will prepare land for the fitness equipment.

Dog Park- Public Works is currently working on rerouting the ditch according to engineer's design and clearing brush.
