

PLEASE DO NOT OPEN OR USE CAN UNTIL MAY 1st, 2022

Coastal Environmental Services is very excited to be your new provider for Solid Waste Collection. We will begin servicing your area effective May 1st. Your current service day(s) will remain the same. As we begin service on May 1st, we wanted to share some things that we felt would be helpful.



- You are receiving One (1) Coastal Environmental Services Cart prior to May 1st. The number that is on your cart is being scanned and the number will be entered into our system along with your location.
- Additional Cart(s) may be rented directly from CES for \$1.00 each per month. The rental fee must be paid up front for an entire year.
- CART CONTENT ONLY please place all solid waste in your cart(s). Please do not overfill the cart(s). The lid should not be open more than 6 inches.
- •Cart(s) should be placed no more than 3 feet from the curb. Cart(s) should be placed at least 3 feet from any vehicle, mailbox, fire hydrant, power pole or other object.
- •All garbage carts and bulky waste piles should NOT be placed under overhanging lines or trees.

- •Please place the handle of your cart(s) toward your house (cart should open toward the street).
- •We will not access any private driveways, private gravel roads etc.
- •Handicap customers will need to contact our office to set up handicap service. Please contact our office and number listed below for information on required documents.
- •Small, round personal carts will not be serviced, all normal collection trash will need to be placed in our 95-gallon cart or one similar in shape and size.
- •Recycle drop sites will still be available throughout the county. Please contact our office for information on where these are located if you are unaware.
