

COURTROOM RULES

Dignity, respect, and decorum are essential to a proper courtroom atmosphere. The following requirements pertain to all parties entering the courtroom.

- NO food or drink
- NO cell phones
- NO audio or video recording
- NO children allowed without prior permission of presiding judge
- NO sunglasses, hats, or headgear
- QUIET while in the courtroom
- NO inappropriate gestures or remarks will be tolerated
- PROPER DRESS IS REQUIRED:

NO exposed midriffs or suggestive clothing

NO tank tops or halter style garments

NO exposed undergarments

NO garments with offensive slogans or advertising alcohol or drugs

NO flip flops

NO sleeping clothes

Do not congregate or gather around courtroom doors
