



COURTROOM RULES

Dignity, respect, and decorum are essential to a proper courtroom atmosphere. The following requirements pertain to all parties entering the courtroom.

- NO food or drink
- NO cell phones
- NO audio or video recording
- NO children allowed without prior permission of presiding judge
- NO sunglasses, hats, or headgear
- QUIET while in the courtroom
- NO inappropriate gestures or remarks will be tolerated
- PROPER DRESS IS REQUIRED:
 - NO exposed midriffs or suggestive clothing
 - NO tank tops or halter style garments
 - NO exposed undergarments
 - NO garments with offensive slogans or advertising alcohol or drugs
 - NO flip flops
 - NO sleeping clothes
- Do not congregate or gather around courtroom doors
