## A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DIAMONDHEAD AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SEEK REIMBURSEMENT FOR COVID-19 EXPENSES

WHEREAS, the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Secures (CARES) Act was passed by Congress and signed into law by President Donald Trump on March 27, 2020:

WHEREAS, The CARES Act is a \$2 trillion economic relief package in response to the public health and economic impacts of COVID-19 which includes a Coronavirus Relief Fund; providing for payments to State, Local, and Tribal governments navigating the impact of the COVID-19 outbreak; and

**WHEREAS**, The CARES Act requires that the payments from the Coronavirus Relief Fund only be used to cover expenses that—

- (1) are necessary expenditures incurred due to the public health emergency with respect to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19);
- (2) were not accounted for in the budget most recently approved as of March 27, 2020 (the date of enactment of the CARES Act) for the State or government; and
- (3) were incurred during the period that begins on March 1, 2020, and ends on December 30, 2020.

WHEREAS, The City of Diamondhead has incurred expenses that meet the criteria for reimbursement under the CARES Act;

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council desire to authorize the City Manager to prepare necessary documentation and seek reimbursement for all eligible expenses under The CARES Act.

**SO BE IT RESOLVED,** the Mayor and Council do hereby resolve to authorize the City Manager to prepare necessary documentation and seek reimbursement for all eligible expenses under The CARES Act.
