

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL (THE "GOVERNING BODY") OF THE CITY OF DIAMONDHEAD, MISSISSIPPI (THE "CITY"), TO ACQUIRE, BY QUITCLAIM DEED, CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY LOCATED WITHIN THE CITY FROM THE PEOPLES BANK.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council (the "Governing Body") of the City of Diamondhead, Mississippi (the "City"), acting for and on behalf of the City, hereby finds and determines as follows:

1. The City is in need of acquiring certain real property for greenspace purposes that is currently owned by THE PEOPLES BANK.
2. The City is authorized to acquire real property pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. §21-17-1.
3. The Peoples Bank, has expressed a willingness to quitclaim the three lots, said property legally described in Exhibit "A" to this resolution
4. The City is willing to accept the donation of the aforementioned property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the Governing Body of the City will accept the donation of the aforementioned property.

SECTION 2. That the Governing Body of the City does hereby authorize the City Attorney to prepare any and all documentation related to the acquisition of the aforementioned property by donation, for the City Manager to execute any necessary documentation to effectuate the donation of the subject property.

The above and foregoing resolution, after having been first reduced to writing, was introduced by Councilmember Depreo, seconded by Councilmember Morgan and the question being put to a roll call vote, the result was as follows:




