RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL (THE "GOVERNING BODY") OF THE CITY OF DIAMONDHEAD, MISSISSIPPI (THE CITY), TO VACATE AND/OR ABANDON 5' DRAINAGE/UTILITY EASEMENTS ON EACH SIDE OF THE COMMON LOT LINE BETWEEN LOTS 24 AND 25 AS WLL AS LOTS 25 AND 26, BLK 2, UNIT 9, PHASE 2, HANCOCK COUNTY, MS LOCATED WITHIN THE CITY OF DIAMONDHEAD

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council (the Governing Body) of the City of Diamondhead, Mississippi (the City), acting for and on behalf of the City, hereby finds and determines as follows:

- 1. The City currently possesses 5' drainage and utility easements on Lots 24, 25 and 26, Blk 2, Unit 9, Phase 2. The request is to abandon 5' of drainage and utility easements on each side of the common lot lines between 24 and 25 as well as 25 and 26, Phase 2, Unit 9, Block 2 (see Exhibit A dated 9-01-2020 by David L. Hattaway).
- 2. Carl Boyanton is the owner of this property and have submitted plans to construct a house. The newly assigned address is 11440 Haleiwa Place.
- 3. Comments from the Diamondhead Water and Sewer District, Diamondhead Public Works Department, Coast Electric Power Association have no objections.
- 4. Further, the City hereby abandons and/or vacates the 5' of drainage and utility easements on each side of the common lot lines between lots 24 and 25 as well as 25 and 26, Phase 2, Unit 9, Block 2. (see Exhibit A dated 9-01-2020 by David L. Hattaway), notwithstanding, retaining the 10' drainage and utility easements on the front and rear of the property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the Governing Body of the City will hereby abandon the selected drainage/utility easements as described in bullet #4.


