RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING AUTHORITY FOR THE CITY OF DIAMONDHEAD REQUESTING THE HANCOCK COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT TO EXPEND FUNDS FOR ADEQUATELY COOLED AND AIR CONDITIONED BUSES FOR ALL STUDENTS

WHEREAS, the City of Diamondhead, (the "City"), is a family friendly community with many children who attend Hancock County Schools; and

WHEREAS, that start date of school has been gradually pushed back from the end of August to the first week of August for Hancock County Students; and

WHEREAS, the average daily high temperature in Hancock County for the month of August is above 90° Fahrenheit; and

WHEREAS, it is well documented that the temperature on at least one Hancock County School District school bus with inadequate air condition was in the mid 80°s while students occupied the school bus and that school buses without air condition can exceed 110° Fahrenheit; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Diamondhead believes that such extreme heat conditions, in an enclosed environment, may create a dangerous condition for some students.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Governing Body of the City of Diamondhead hereby requests the Hancock County School District adequately cool and air condition all school buses in order to provide a safe environment for children.
