WHEREAS, the City Council, hereby waives its building permit fee for the Diamondhead Water and Sewer District's wastewater treatment facility; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY, the City Council of the City of Diamondhead, Mississippi, hereby waives its building permit fee for the Diamondhead Water and Sewer District's wastewater treatment facility.
