A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL, ("THE GOVERNING BODY") OF THE CITY OF DIAMONDHEAD, MISSISSIPPI, RESCINDING RESOLUTIONS 2013-040, 2013-045, AND 2013-076 WHICH ESTABLISHED "KEEP DIAMONDHEAD BEAUTIFUL" AS A COMMITTEE OF THE CITY.

WHEREAS, in 2013 the Governing Body, under a prior administration, passed Resolution 2013-40 (later amended by Resolutions 2013-45 and 2013-76) establishing the "Keep Diamondhead Beautiful Committee" and appointing the Chairman of the Committee;

WHEREAS, the "Keep Diamondhead Beautiful Committee" has provided a invaluable service to the City by working with the Hancock Chamber Beautification Committee and "Keep America Beautiful" Inc., to keep the City clean and beautiful;

WHEREAS, the "Keep Diamondhead Beautiful Committee" desires to apply for and receive various grants and funds as a non-profit independent of the Governing Body.

WHEREAS, the Governing Body desires to continue to work with the "Keep Diamondhead Beautiful Committee" as an independent non-profit to keep the City clean and beautiful;

WHEREAS, in order to allow the "Keep Diamondhead Beautiful Committee to operate an independent non-profit the Governing Body desires to rescind Resolutions 2013-40, 2013-45 and 2013-76.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, AS FOLLOWS:

Resolutions 2013-40, 2013-45, and 2013-76 establishing the Keep Diamondhead Beautiful Committee as a Committee of the City are hereby rescinded.
