## RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE MEMA DISTRICT 9 REGIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

**WHERAS**, the City of Diamondhead is vulnerable to any array of natural hazards that can cause loss of life and damages too public and private property; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Diamondhead desires to seek ways to mitigate situation that may aggravate such circumstances; and

**WHEREAS**, the development and implementation of a hazard mitigation plan can result in actions that reduce the long-term risks to life and property from natural hazards; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the intent of the City of Diamondhead to protect its citizens and property from the effects of natural hazards by preparing and maintaining a local hazard mitigation plan; and

WHEREAS, it is also the intent of the City of Diamondhead to fulfill its obligation under Section 322; Mitigation Planning, of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act to remain eligible to receive state and federal assistance in the event of a declared disaster affecting the City of Diamondhead; and

WHEREAS, City of Diamondhead, in coordination with George, Hancock, Harrison, Jackson, Pearl River and Stone Counties and the participating municipalities within those counties, has prepared a multi-jurisdictional hazard mitigation plan pending the completion of the local adoption procedures;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Mayor and Council of the City of Diamondhead hereby:

- 1. Adopt the MEMA District 9 Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan; and
- 2. Agrees to take such other official action as me be reasonably necessary to carry out the proposed actions of the Plan.
